

The children attend school five days a week and eleven months per year. The school was established in 2005 with just a few classes and students, but today we have 24 classrooms, two offices, a library room and only 10 toilets. The school is blessed with 100 devoted teachers - mostly women - and we all work tirelessly to help the students get a better education.

We know that connecting with others through this partnership will pave the way to gaining more knowledge, skills and experience. We are looking to share with you our testimonies, subjects and experience, and our students will be able to share their work and future dreams with your students.

Our partnership with African Adventures has brought many benefits to our school, including renovations to our classrooms, improvements to our library, the construction of a security wall, and more sports equipment for our students to use. We hope that having a UK school partner will take us even further and help us to achieve even more.
